
## RELIGIOUS VIOLENCE IN POST-WAR SRI LANKA: INCIDENTS AND ATTACKS

### **BETWEEN MAY 2009-JANUARY 2013**



# CPA recorded a total of 65 attacks on places of religious worship.

Recorded attacks highlight widespread religious tensions across Sri Lanka.

An 'attack' is defined as: Physical violence against a religious place and includes damage to building/s, theft of and/or damage to items within the building, injury or death of persons within. All religious communities face various forms of violence.

CPA's record of numbers of incidents is conservative.


### INCIDENTS OF VIOLENCE & INTIMIDATION AGAINST THE CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY

### The National Christian Evangelical Alliance (NCEASL)

Recorded 103 incidents in 2013 and 69 incidents in 2014.

#### The Sri Lanka Muslim Congress (SLMC)

Reported 241 anti-Muslim attacks in 2013.
